Small Group Questions

- 1. Three weeks into our series on Heaven, how are you processing the teaching and understanding that Heaven is a physical place?
- 2. Reflect on Randy Alcorn's quote: Though God chooses to dwell in Heaven, he does not need a dwelling place.

 However, as finite humans, we do. It's no problem for the all-powerful God, a spirit, to dwell in a spiritual realm or a physical realm or a realm that includes both. The real question is whether people, being by nature both spiritual and physical, can dwell in a realm without physical properties.

Alcorn is assuming that to be human is both spiritual and physical...how do you respond to what he's saying? Do you agree? Why or why not?

- 3. Read Hebrew 8:5. If earth is a copy and a shadow of heavenly things, then what does that tell us about the nature of Heaven? If earth is like a blueprint of Heaven, what are the implications?
- 4. Pastor Dan talked about what rest will look like in a restored state without sin. What activities are you most looking forward to experiencing in Heaven without the curse of sin? (For example: in our life here on earth, at times we have a tendency to eat, work, play and take it to an unhealthy extreme. In Heaven where there are no sinful tendencies like this, what are you most excited about? Said another way, how is the curse of sin diminishing your experience of even the 'good' things of life here on earth? What do you long to be free from?)
