### How to Get Started with your Apprenticeship Prayer Partners

We know that many people who want to grow in their apprenticeship walk with Jesus also experience some apprehension and even intimidation when they consider this kind of lifestyle. The following suggestions are ways to get you started in this life-transforming journey.

Every A.P.P. should look to incorporate 3 core aspects:

## Share... Reflect... Pray...

The *Starting Point* suggestions assume you feel a little intimidated, that you're not used to sharing your life openly, to praying with people, and so these provide simple on-ramps.

The *Next step* suggestions assume some growing trust in relationship, a greater commitment to re-ordering your life, and that you're willing to risk going to another level with each other.

The *Going Deeper* section suggestions really start to get to the "life on life" transformation potential within these groups. This is really where the real-life transformation happens. The *Starting Point* and the *Next Step* will get you moving, but the *Going Deeper* section is really what will accelerate your growth.

#### Share

Starting Point	What are you thanking God for this past week?		
Next Step	Where did you sense the prompting of Jesus this past week and did you obey?		
Going Deeper	Identify 3-5 accountability questions (related to connection with God, use of speech, relationships, sex, finance, etc.). *See APP Field Guide for sample questions.		

#### Reflect

Starting Point Read one Proverb a day for one month (there are 31

chapters in the book of Proverbs). Then read one Psalm a day (there are 150 Psalms – could be done for 5 months). Highlight one verse each day that stands out to you. Share one or two verses that stood out to you

and why when you get together.

Next Step Follow a daily reading plan together.\* Highlight one

verse that stands out to you each day. Write out a 1-3 sentence prayer asking the Holy Spirit to help you do what it says. Text the prayer to your APPs each day.\*\*

*Going Deeper* Follow a daily reading plan together. Write a short

journal reflection on one verse or one idea that stands out to you, followed by a short, written prayer. Text the

reflection and prayer to you're A.P.Ps.

#### **Pray**

Starting Point Share one praise report & prayer request each week

and commit to praying for each other *on your own* 2-3x a week. (Bonus – consider writing out a 1-2 sentence

prayer and text it to your APP.)

*Next Step* Share one praise report & prayer request each week

and *pray together* for each other. Commit to praying for someone in each other's relational circles who doesn't

yet know Jesus.

Going Deeper Listen in prayer for each other, asking Jesus for words

of encouragement and wisdom.

## **Apprenticeship Prayer Partner Challenge**

What one thing can we do to be more intentional in our APP relationship? (Think: how do we grow deeper in Sharing, Reflecting, Praying?)
